

CALLING AND GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPATING IN THE FUNDING OF PUBLIC COMMUNITY WORKS AND HOUSING IMPROVEMENT 2008

FIRST. This is a program developed and managed by CONGREGACIÓN MARIANA TRINITARIA, A.C., with its own funding, and whose objective consists of providing support to public and private institutions and governments with defined actions. This program is focused preferentially and principally on funding public community works and housing improvement.

CONGREGACIÓN MARIANA TRINITARIA A.C. WILL CONTRIBUTE, USING LOST FUNDS, UP TO 50% OF THE COST OF WORKS THAT ARE PRESENTED, WHETHER FOR THE IMPROVEMENT, EXPANSION OR NEW CONSTRUCTION; WITHOUT SETTING A LIMIT ON THE RESOURCES THAT WILL BE USED, AS LONG AS THE RESOURCES GRANTED ARE FOR INDUSTRIAL MATERIALS.

SECOND. The following can participate: PUBLIC OR PRIVATE INSTITUTIONS, MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENTS, STATE GOVERNMENTS OF ANY FEDERAL ENTITY; coming from all municipalities, communities, agencies, ranches, settlements, and congregations. LOCATION, DISTANCE, LEVEL OF INACCESSIBILITY AND MARGINALITY DO NOT MATTER.

THE COUNTRY OF ORIGIN IS NOT CONSIDERED AS LONG AS PROPOSALS ARE PRESENTED IN SPANISH OR IN ENGLISH.

THIRD. All petitions that are presented will be accepted for study and evaluation.

FOURTH. There will not be a limit to the number of works or the number of housing situations to improve.

FIFTH. Petitioners should present:

1. Original written petition of the petitioner, clearly indicating the concept or description of the work to be done, current residence and zip code of the petitioner, telephone (where they answer or receive messages), name of institution, government, or person petitioning and of the representative (with his or her signature).
2. Original technical file, signed.
3. A copy of the plans of the work to be done.
4. Sketch of the location.
5. 6 (six) recent photographs of the location of the work.

6. Copy of the petitioner's identification.

SIXTH. The duration of this calling is open for all fiscal activity in 2008, but could close without notification.

SEVENTH. The petitions that comply with the above indicated, will be evaluated by the ADMINISTRATIVE COUNSEL OF CONGREGACIÓN MARIANA TRINITARIA, A.C., according to the rules and internal norms established with their own organic conformation.

EIGHTH. THE ADMINISTRATIVE COUNSEL OF CONGREGACIÓN MARIANA TRINITARIA, A.C., according to its organic conformation will operate under membership and will evaluate the petitions with bases in the needs of the institution and the problematic to be resolved, identification and characteristics of the population to benefit, clarity and congruency in the approach of the petition; AS THE VIABILITY AND PERCENTAGE OF SUPPORT.

NINTH. Notification will be given in writing through the available physical or electronic media to the participating institutions IN A MAXIMUM OF 5 WORK DAYS (THIS TIME PERIOD DOES NOT APPLY TO COUNTRIES OUTSIDE OF MEXICO), of the final result of the presented petitions as well as the funding assigned.

TENTH. The aspects not considered within the present calling will be resolved based on the criteria of CONGREGACIÓN MARIANA TRINITARIA, A.C.

"This program is of a private nature. Its use for political, electoral or other types of profit or gain apart from those here established is prohibited".
